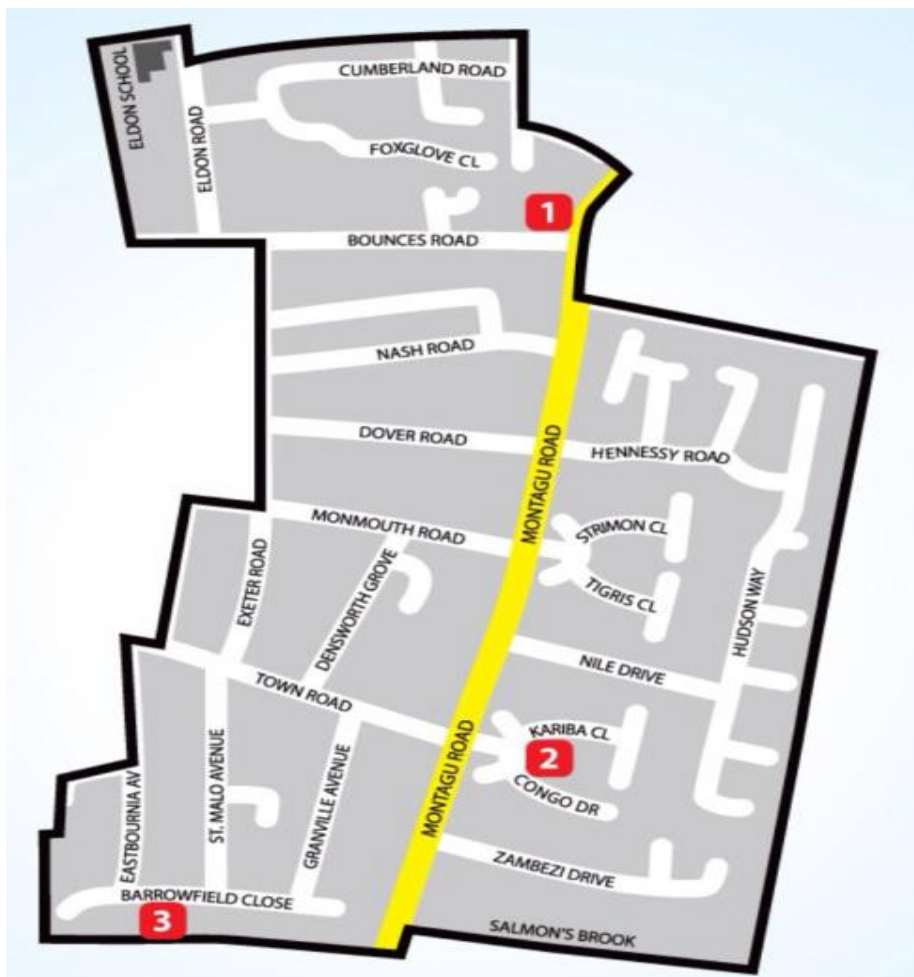
All courses are local and FREE to those who live, work, volunteer or study in the Bountagu area. See map below. If you are outside of the area – there will be a charge.
